CONFERENCE ON MANAGEMENT FOR CREATIVITY AND INNOVATIVE PRACTICES

The CREAPI conference was created in 2022 with the main objective of promoting ongoing or completed research related to the management of creativity and innovative practices, and exchanging on related themes and the issues they raise.

The aim of the conference is to provide opportunities for reflection, exchange and debate around researches related to a wide range of innovative and creative practices (technical and technological innovations, managerial innovations, marketing innovations, accounting and financial innovations, social innovations aiming at improving people well-being, innovations available to territories...) considered in various environments (industrial sector, services sector including organisations dedicated to care and public services, third sector, etc.) and through several types of questioning.

The 2024 edition (2nd edition) will be structured around:

- Thematic sessions addressing specific topics around the following theme: The art of promoting and cultivating creativity in organizations. Thematic sessions could be devoted to the following topics:
 - Management of cultural and creative organisations;
 - Entrepreneurial creativity;
 - Creativity in the management profession;
 - Creativity in management education;
 - Catalysts for creativity in the workplace (collective intelligence, mindfulness, etc.);
 - Developing creative and artistic skills of human resources;
 - Art and culture at the service of management.
- varia sessions will be open to proposals that do not fall within the above-mentioned thematics.

Interested researchers are therefore invited to submit their proposals either in link with the main theme or in a separate topic.

The topics listed in this call for papers are intended as a starting point for discussion and should not be regarded as exhaustive. This conference on the management of creativity and innovative practices is intended to be open. This openness concerns the theoretical frameworks used, the methodological choices made and the fields of study.
